

COVID-19 vaccination

Having your vaccine at Bramley Village Health & Wellbeing Centre

Please read the following information before your COVID-19 vaccination appointment, remember to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt from wearing one), sanitise your hands on arrival and when leaving, and keep your distance ideally two metres apart where possible.

Here's what you need to do when you arrive for your vaccine

When you arrive please be aware that there is a separate entrance for patients having their vaccines, the entrance will be marked as 'Covid vaccinations entrance only'. There will be a separate entrance for patients attending the practice.

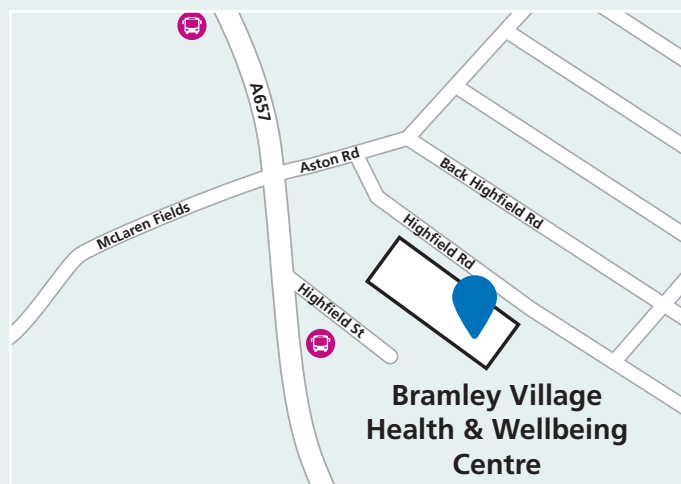
Bringing someone with you to your appointment

If you're bringing someone with you, please ask them to wait in the car or they'll be asked to wait outside if they don't have a car. If you need their assistance, they can go into the practice with you, please ensure they have a face covering (unless they are exempt from wearing one).
