1	Greeting and Safety			
2 / 2.1	There were no matters arising.			
3	Practice Update; JL updated members that we have achieved our end of year targets and had worked hard on this. She also explained that we are now partaking in the Spring Covid Vaccine campaign along with Biddulph Valley Surgery and Leek Health Centre. Clinics are for the 75 and over, care home residents and immunosuppressed and will be completed in core hours throughout April/May here at the Surgery. The practice had been informed that there were no other sites in Biddulph that will be holding clinics.			
	BK said that the invites will be sent via a text message with an attached booking link so the patients can book directly for a day and time that suits them. There will be a clinic in the AM and PM on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday where possible.			

	Seats will be placed outside Room 41 for easy access and no queuing needed at the reception desk.	
	JL – signed up for a schemed called Modern General practice and	
	a plan will be put together on what we need to focus on as a	
	Practice. She explained briefly that they are wanting us to look at	
	other ways patients can book appointments other than calling in	
	the morning (avoiding the 8am rush). They will be looking at the	
	reports from the new telephone system to see how many callers	
	we have had, how many were answered, how many were dropped. Possibly looking at adding more online consultations	
	and others way patients can contact us for admin queries.	
	Making more appointments available through the NHS app etc.	
	How we can reduce the DNA's. OM asked if they had improved,	
	both JL and BK said they were below 100 last month which is the	
	best they have been for a while. We have advertised the new	
	cancellation system (calling the surgery and selecting option 5).  Possible other option is to have a dedicated cancellation line	
	where patients can leave a message. JL pointed out though that	
	if a patient wanted to rearrange their appointment at the same	
	time as cancelling they would be unable to do so using this	
	method. Members praised the new phone system and the	
	training the Patient Care Co-ordinators have been given leading to excellent care navigation.	
	JL – registered us to be a dementia friendly practice with a view	
	to all staff becoming dementia friends. Alerts will be added on to	
	the patient record to tell staff they have dementia so extra	
	support can be given.	
4	NHS App;	
	BK explained there will be a drop in clinic on Thursday 11 <sup>th</sup> April	
	from 13:30 – 15:00. Invites have been sent out to all patients	
	that have not yet got the app downloaded. 8 patients have	
	confirmed their attendance. We will start by showing some short videos explaining what the NHS app is and how it can help	
	patients. If after this the patient would like the app downloaded	
	on their smartphone, we will do this for them. SF asked if it can	
	be downloaded without photo ID which it can be.	
	BK asked for volunteers to help tomorrow. DO stated that she	
	would help along with PP and ST but we have had apologies from	
	both that they are unfortunately unable to attend. OM has also offered to help and possible PS if he is well enough.
